Dear Editor:

We read your case report titled 'Successful Treatment of Chronic Coccydynia with Peripheral Nerve stimulation: A Case Report' with great interest which was informative and discusses a novel idea for the management of chronic coccydynia. (1)

Pain in coccydynia is mostly nociceptive; sometimes as in this case it may be mixed nociceptive and neuropathic. (2,3) Peripheral nerve stimulation is usually beneficial in neuropathic pain conditions; hence, it should be recommended in those cases of coccydynia where nature of pain is mixed nociceptive and neuropathic.

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
